Jeremy Sams is an award winning representational artist residing in Archdale, NC. His primary subject matter is landscapes while working in acrylics. He also loves the challenge of portraits and his work varies in size from just a few sq. inches to murals measuring upward of 40'x60'.



Jeremy's personal inspirations come primarily from the play of light and atmosphere and their effects on objects and landscapes. His most favorite areas of subject matter are the rolling hills and mountains of North Carolina along with its waterways, and special array of trees and meadows. Eligibility:

Open to all artists 18 yrs. and older. All work must be for sale. Work must be original and executed in the past two years. A maximum of two works may be submitted. Work must not have been exhibited in previous Sampson Arts Council Juried Art Exhibitions.

Requirements for Entries:

Participants must submit a CD with a maximum of three (3) entries, which must be completely original by the artist.

CD due date: April 1, 2015

Digital size limitations: 300dpi and 1200 pixels (longest side) recommended.

Mail the registration form with a CD containing your appropriately formatted images to: Sampson Arts Council, 709 College St., Clinton, NC 28328

Artists will be notified of entries chosen (maximum of two). **Artwork is to be delivered to the Victor R. Small House on April 16, 2015, from 10am – 6pm.**

General Information

Due to limited space, art must not exceed 48" (including frame) in any dimension or weigh more than 50 lbs. All work must be framed, wired (no saw-tooth hangers) and ready for hanging or otherwise suitably prepared for exhibition or it will not be accepted. The Sampson Arts Council reserves the right to reject any entry that requires special installation or care.

Entry Fees:

Maximum of (2) entries: \$25.00

Awards:

The following awards and ribbons are presented at the discretion of the judge:

Best in Show.....\$500.00

1st Place.....\$250.00

2nd Place.....\$150.00

3rd Place.....\$50.00

Honorable Mention.....Ribbon

The Gallery is open Tuesday-Friday from 10am until 2pm and by appointment.

Art Sales and Pricing:

SAC prefers all art be for sale. A \$15 fee will be charged for each entry that is not for sale. To assist you with pricing, art priced between \$250-\$900 has a better chance of selling. Prices may not change once the exhibit opens. SAC retains a 30% commission on all sales.

Art Removal:

Art must remain on exhibit until June 19, 2015. Due to lack of storage, removal of entries may begin June 22, 2015, 10am to 5pm.

Liability:

All reasonable care will be given in the handling and display of the art, and all art exhibited is insured from time of delivery until 5pm on June 22, 2015. SAC staff, representatives and or sponsors assume no responsibility for the loss of or damage to art.

Rights & Conditions:

The artist grants SAC permission to photograph and reproduce any art for publicity and educational purposes. SAC reserves the right to refuse, remove, or reject any art. Entry of art constitutes agreement with conditions described herein.
